

## **HOSTEL OUTDOOR PURSUITS POLICY**

### **Policy**

The organization and implementation of the Hostel Outdoor Pursuits programme is the responsibility of the hostel manager.

All hostel students participate in an outdoor pursuits experience each Sunday during term time.

The Sunday programme is designed to complement and/or enhance the college's Outdoor Pursuits programme.

### **Procedures**

1. The outdoor pursuit programme is planned by the hostel outdoor pursuit supervisor in consultation with the hostel manager.
2. A copy of the term's programme is posted on the information noticeboard at the hostel.
3. The hostel outdoor pursuit supervisor engages specialist tutors as required to assist with the Sunday programme within the budgeted allowance in accordance with the college's employment policy.
4. Students are expected to take part in every hostel outdoor pursuit session unless they have been formally excused due to injury, illness or other reason deemed acceptable by the hostel manager.
5. All staff and students involved in the Sunday programme are required to comply with the college's Outdoor Safety Management document.
6. The hostel outdoor pursuit supervisor must liaise with the college's head of outdoor pursuits concerning the availability of equipment and resources for the Sunday programme.
7. The hostel has a priority right over the booking of the mini-buses and outdoor pursuit equipment for Sunday use.
