

LEVEL 1 STATIONERY LIST 2024

We recommend you purchase students' stationery in time for the start of school in Term 1 as students will begin using their stationery on the first day of school.

Where to purchase stationery

Stationery can be ordered from the commercial outlet of your choice. However, from January each year, Paper Plus Wānaka offers an [online ordering option](#) (school name – Mount Aspiring College) so that you can purchase stationery and either collect your order from the store or have it delivered to your home.

Additional materials

Please check the college's [course guide](#) for any additional materials students may need for selected subjects. These materials are provided in class and will be added to your school account. Teachers may ask parents of homeroom students to purchase additional stationery items if needed.

Digital devices (BYOD)

We expect all students to bring an appropriate device to school and use it to support their learning. You can [read more about recommended devices](#) on our website.

At all times students in Year 11 need:

- 1 HB pencil
- 1 30cm ruler (non bendy)
- 1 soft eraser
- 1 red and 1 blue biro
- 1 small set coloured pencils
- 1 glue stick
- 1 highlighter pen
- 1 A4 ring binder folder
- 1 A4 refill
- 1 clear file (40 pages) for handouts for ALL subjects not already detailed.
- 1 set of earbuds or headphones for all BYOD work (with an in-line microphone for dictation if necessary).

Te Kura

Students studying a language subject via Te Kura should have their own recording device.

Backups

A hard drive / memory stick for backups is optional as Google Drive is also available. Whatever option, students need to take responsibility for making their own backups.
